Students must have a 2.0 GPA, been involved in co-curricular and community service activities, be a US citizen or permanent resident and have a critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross income per family). Computer Science, Computer or Electrical Engineering

- * Tuition and fees up to \$30,000 per year
- * Housing and travel entitlements during summer employment (if the distance between NSA and the school exceeds 75 miles)
- * Year-round salary and employment with NSA after graduation
- * You must be a U.S. citizen
- * You must be a high school senior at time of application
- * You must achieve a minimum ACT of 25 or SAT/College Board score of 1600 (1100 Critical Reading and Math, 500 in Writing)
- * You must have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- * You must demonstrate leadership abilities
